Unemployment Compensation:

- Members may be eligible for unemployment benefits due to reduced hours and/or reduced wages. To <u>file a claim</u> for unemployment insurance online:
 - Gather required information (Valid CA identification, most recent employer's information, and employment history over the past 18 months) and use the general website, https://edd.ca.gov/, to access EDD online.

- For Universal Studios Hollywood & Universal-owned CityWalk employees only: Universal Studios Hollywood Team Member Assistance Fund was started to assist Team Members facing severe financial hardship resulting from a sudden, unforeseen catastrophic or emergency event in their lives through no fault of their own and provides short-term direct assistance for applicants who meet the Fund's eligibility criteria.
 - Applying to the TM Assistance Fund: Applications can be found on MyUSH (TM Kiosks on-site) or picked up from Team Member Central (5511-3) or 5511-5th floor.

Before applying for assistance from the Fund, Team Member should have exhausted all resources reasonably available which may include:

- Health, disability, life or other insurance benefits
- Unemployment Wages
- Personal Savings
- Loans
- Government or Community Assistance Programs
- Applications are required to be completed in full with detailed information regarding the qualifying event, financial hardship incurred, and documentation of hardship and proof of amount owed must be submitted along with application. Completed applications can be dropped off at Team Member Central (5511-3), 5511-5th floor, or by emailing USH.TMFund@udx.com. Submitting an application does not guarantee approval for TM Assistance Fund Grant. Submitted applications will be reviewed by the TM Assistance Fund Review Board to determine meeting criteria.

 and scheduling. Note: You will still be subject to the 480-hour "evaluation period".
 - Language above applies for up to nine (9) months following a permanent attraction closure.
